### Class Description:

These darling mini flags create a banner that will welcome Spring when you are wanting the change in seasons! Using felt applique to embellish fabric flags gives this banner dimension and flair. Adding embroidery stitches enhances the details of the applique and makes each banner truly a work of art. The flags finish at 3 1/2" x 4 1/2". The finished banner can be made longer or shorter by adding extra flags, embellishing with felt poms or wood beads or simply spacing the flags further apart.

### Fabric Requirements:

- Various colors of wool blend felt (I recommend Benzie design to purchase. Because pieces are small it is recommended to use wool felt and not woven wool)
- Embroidery Floss that coordinates with felt and additional contrasting colors for embroidery as desired.
- 5- 10" fabric squares

### Supplies Needed:

- Embroidery needle
- Needle Threader (optional, but helpful)
- Sharp Scissors
- If finishing in the hoop: 3" Embroidery Hoop
- 5" square of fabric
